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Intercultural Education Program Introduction

The location that you are going to live and work in

China has a civilisation with a history of nearly 5,000 years, but only experienced reform and opening up more than forty years ago. Most Chinese people had access to the world outside China later than other countries, and English as an internationally spoken language was known and learnt then, which led to the low level of English among most citizens. Although currently in China students start learning English at an early age, it is only used as a subject for exams and not as a language for communication. Traditional English education methods are unable to improve the low level of English communication and comprehensible understanding skills of learners, and the fill-in-the-blank approach to learning English only leads to machine learning and a lack of flexibility and independent thinking. To change this, excellent ESL teachers and a well-developed ESL teaching system are required.

The founder of our program has travelled the world and met young people from many different countries, whose intelligence, love of life, and sense of social responsibility she can relate to. She has been able to interact with them and learnt that they are eager to work and learn to improve their abilities, expand their horizons and gain insights, which will be beneficial to the educational system in China. Thus, a program of intercultural education has been set up. The core of the program is to provide an excellent ESL learning atmosphere with excellent foreign English teachers in the form of English classes, art classes, music classes, drama classes, and physical education classes. IEC will cover your airfare, work visa, accommodation, insurance, transportation, monthly cultural exchange activities, and professional training during the program time.

IEC would love to welcome recent graduates and young professionals to China to spend 10 to 11 months experiencing the sights and food, the customs and traditions of China, learn about Chinese traditional and modern culture, and use your love and enthusiasm to help young learners broaden new horizons in language learning. 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Guangdong Province in China

The location that you are going to live and work



Guangdong Province is located in southern China and has 21 cities (Guangzhou, Shenzhen, Foshan, Dongguan, Zhongshan, Zhuhai, Jiangmen, Zhaoqing, Huizhou; Eastern Guangdong: Shantou, Chaozhou, Jieyang, Shanwei; Western Guangdong: Zhanjiang, Maoming, Yangjiang, Yunfu; Northern Guangdong: Shaoguan, Qingyuan, Meizhou, Heyuan). The permanent resident population of the province is 113.46 million. The GDP of the province has been ranked as number 1 in the country for 33 years.

Nine cities in Guangdong Province (Guangzhou, Shenzhen, Foshan, Dongguan, Zhongshan, Zhuhai, Jiangmen, Zhaoqing, Huizhou) as well as Hong Kong and Macao will work together to build the Guangdong Hong Kong Macao Greater Bay Area, which will become one of the four Bay areas in the world alongside the New York Bay area, the San Francisco Bay area, and the Tokyo Bay area. In October 2019, it was selected into the national digital economy innovation and development pilot zone.

Guangdong Province belongs to the East Asian monsoon region, with a mid-subtropical, south-subtropical and tropical climate from north to south and is one of the regions with the most abundant light, heat and water resources in China. The annual average temperature is about 19℃ -24℃. The average number of sunshine hours in the province is 1745.8 hours and the annual average temperature is 22.3℃. The average temperature in January is about 16℃ - 19℃, and in July it is about 28℃ - 29℃.

Zhongshan City- Where IEC Locates

Zhongshan City is part of Guangdong Province, with 24 towns and districts. It is located in the middle of Guangdong Province and is conveniently connected to Guangzhou, Shenzhen, Dongguan, Foshan, Zhuhai, Hong Kong and Macao within a radius of 90 kilometres. The city has a total area of 1,900 square kilometers, an annual average temperature of 20℃ and a resident population of 5.4 million. Zhongshan is the hometown of the great man of the generation, Dr. Sun Yat-sen. Also, Zhongshan is a famous hometown of overseas Chinese, with more than 800,000 overseas Chinese, Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan compatriots living in 87 countries and regions on five continents of the world. It is known as the hometown of overseas Chinese, it is one of the most open coastal cities in China.

Zhongshan is a coastal area, a subtropical monsoon climate region, with a mild climate and abundant rainfall, with an average annual temperature of 21.8℃ and an average annual rainfall of 1,747.4mm. The city has been awarded as "National Sanitary City", "National Garden City", "National Advanced City in Science and Technology", "National Environmental Protection City", "Civilised City of Guangdong Province", "National Advanced City in Building a Civilised City", as well as the honor of "Best Example of Human Living Environment Award" awarded by the United Nations. It is also named as the Eco-tourism Agricultural Base of Guangdong Province.

How can I apply for this program?

When can I have an interview after I submit application?

Responses will be given within 3 working days.

Will school interview me?

It depends, some school would request an interview with teachers (our candidates), others will authorise IEC to do the interview.

07

After this program, what options are available to me?

You can stay with IEC with the same school or another schools.
You can find other schools in the whole China by yourself.
You can go back to your own country or other countries.

08

Will IEC provide training?

Yes, considering most of our candidates do not have Chinese education background and teaching experience, we will provide systematic training including pre-departure online training, pre-job training after arrival in China and on-going training and support during the program term.

09

How many hours do I need to work on weekdays?

No more than 8 hours per day.

Do we only teach English in classes?

You will teach young learners all subjects in English

Who will pay for the flight ticket?

IEC provides one-way flight ticket from your country of residence to China, a return ticket can be purchased by yourself with the completion bonus of RMB 4,000.

How much do we need to prepare for living expenses in China each month?

Basically no need, IEC provides work visa, accommodation, meals, insurance, first daily necessities upon arrival, teaching support, monthly activities, and salary.

How will meals and accommodations be arranged?

A

School will provide work meals on working day. IEC will provide clean, equipped, safe accommodation for all the teachers. You will share the apartment (living room, bathroom, kitchen and balcony) with 1-2 teachers, and you will have your own bedroom.

Q14

What kind of monthly activities we will have?

A

Activities that immerse Chinese traditional and modern culture, different kind of local food discovery and local life experience.

Q15

How to deal with culture shock?

A

You should talk to your mentor and express your feelings. Meanwhile try to learn the history and culture of this country. You may try to make some Chinese friends as well.

Q16

Is China a safe place to live?

A

Yes, China now is one of the safest place to live in, the crime rate is very low in societies.

Q17

When will I go to China?

A

As soon as you get Z-visa from China Embassy/Consulate in your country, you would be expected to travel within a week or two.

Q18

Can I go back to my home country during the program?

A

Yes, once your application to leave during the Program Term gets approval by School and IEC, you will be free to leave, but there will be a cost which will be on your own expenses.

Q19

When should I prepare for the work visa?

A

Once you sign the Program Agreement with IEC.

Q20

How long does it take to apply for the work visa?

A

2-3 months for documents collection, 7 working days to apply for work visa in Chinese embassy/consulate in the country of your residence.

Q21

Does IEC provide a certificate for program completion?

A

Yes, IEC will provide all teachers a certificate to reward your excellent performance and a recommendation letter for your next career to demonstrate your performance during the Program Term.

Q22

Do we need to interview with the school?

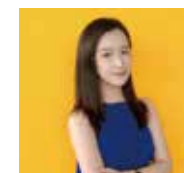

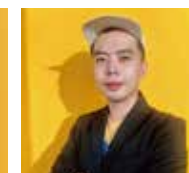
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
